**Host Family Letter** 

This is an exciting opportunity: hosting a foreign student gives one an opportunity to have a glimpse into a different culture, to exchange information and to make new friends. More often families with children will offer to host a student however, from our experience, even if you are a couple without children you'll have a wonderful time!

The rules of becoming a host family are mostly common sense- take care of the student as of your own, include her in your daily life activities, create a sense of family, and ensure safety. Because of the core volunteer flair of this program and limited financial resources the host family will provide for meals, for the child's own bedroom or if not possible for a room ( separate bed) to be shared with a same gender child.

Some means for communication with the student's family should be encouraged via email, phone calls, etc. Skype is free for internet communication. Student should be told the house rules and reminded as necessary since the first week of arrival. They are not allowed to participate in extreme sports, driving, alcohol consumption, smoking or any other health risk situations. Swimming should happen only under direct supervision. EERC needs to be informed of travel outside Massachusetts. Because of the student young age they can not be trusted to have babysitting duties. Seat belt wearing is mandatory while riding a car. Although not preferably, in case of emergencies (sickness, emergent travel, etc) EERC will try to place the student with other families.

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Educational Enrichment for Romanian

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The host family is considered a volunteer therefore no payment is involved, a tax deduction may be possible in some cases. In special cases a small weekly stipend for the family will be

considered. Please note EERC is a volunteer based organization.

**About the students:** 

The students are ages 13-15, fluent English speaking, are in excellent academic standing,

chosen in a competitive process for overall accomplishments. They will arrive at the end of

June few days before Summer camp starts and leave 4-5 weeks later depending when the

school program ends. The students are expected to attend the camp if they are enrolled

unless in illness situations or other valid exceptions. The EERC team should be contacted if

such situations would arise. EERC students are selected through a competitive process for

their overall accomplishments, they all speak English well, have catastrophic medical

insurance, full immunization list, updates medical file. We have few physicians, dentists and a

pediatrician in the board.

A separate sheet with contact info and dates will be distributed before their arrival.

How to become a host family:

Each family has to fill out an application. The host family needs at least one reference

(community, work or friends). EERC representative(s) will meet with all family members,

during a home visit. If qualified the host family will become involved in the selection.

Procedure:

1. Fill in Host Application and email to florentina@eercboston.org

2. EERC will schedule Home visit with all family members present

3. Host family reviews student folder

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- 4. EERC will connect student -host family via email
- 5. Student airport pickup
- 6. Some weekend participation with EERC activities ( welcoming party, Boston tours), host families are encouraged to attend
- 7. Student drop off airport for departure

Altogether this is a wonderful opportunity for both the host family and the student to Understand and appreciate another culture! Thank you for making it possible!
